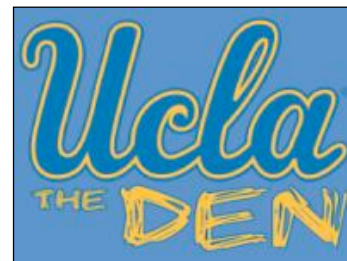




## UCLA MEN'S BASKETBALL PRIORITY NUMBERS



### GUIDELINES FOR ADMITTANCE TO THE FLOOR LEVEL (FLOOR/BLEACHER SEATS)

#### Basic Information

Rally Committee and The DEN oversee a Priority Number system for permitting a limited number of students to sit in the floor level student section at UCLA Men's Basketball home games. The floor level includes sections 111B, 112A, 112B, 113A, 113B, and 114A in Pauley Pavilion.

**Priority Numbers are only valid for DEN Season Ticket holders.** Up to 500 Numbers will be distributed, but the quantity is subject to change without notice. Having a Priority Number (hereafter called Number) does not guarantee you a floor level seat. The number of students holding Numbers that are actually admitted to the floor level section varies.

Each Number is valid for the single game, date and time indicated only. Hand-written on each is a number used for determining the order in which students are admitted to the floor level.

A student's Number may be considered invalid if (s)he is not at Gate Ten 1½ hours prior to game time, OR if (s)he is not in the correct place in line when doors open. Doors open to the first individual in line (Number #1) 1 hour prior to game time.

#### Sign-Up List & First Distribution

An official sign-up list for the floor level will be posted by The DEN at Gate Ten the day before every game. You are allowed to sign up with one partner – if you do, please write both names in the same row.

Once you sign in, either you or your partner must be in the line at Pauley (or excused) at ALL times. The DEN will be conducting random roll calls. If at any time a line monitor finds neither of you present/excused, both names will be crossed off the list. If you are the partner in line, you may only be excused for a bathroom break of 10 minutes. You MUST notify the line monitor when you leave AND when you return to be considered excused.

From 6:30am the morning of the game, Rally Committee will give out Numbers at Gate Ten in order of sign-up. One partner must be present at that time to claim the Number(s). After those present from the list have been served, remaining Numbers are given out on a first come, first served basis until 7:00am. Any remaining Numbers are made available at Second Distribution.

Note: Only the official sign-up list will be accepted. If the official list is gone or destroyed by the time Rally Committee arrives, Rally Committee and The DEN will distribute Numbers at their discretion.

#### Second Distribution

Rally Committee gives out any remaining Numbers from First Distribution at Gate Ten beginning 2½ hours before game time on a first come, first served basis.

#### Rules for Receiving Numbers

- **In order to receive a Number, you must present your UCLA BruinCard.** No other forms of identification will be accepted and you will not be given a Number if you do not have your BruinCard. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- An individual at either Distribution may receive a maximum of two Numbers, and only receive one time. **(S)he must present two different people's BruinCards to receive two Numbers!**  
(And to reserve two Numbers using the Sign-Up List, an individual must have written two names in the same row. Also, two partners from the List cannot get more than two Numbers between them if they both show up at First Distribution. Only one partner from the List needs to be present at First Distribution.)

#### Timeline

Day before Game	Sign-Up List posted
Day of Game: 6:30-7:00am	Numbers distributed to names on List, then first come first served
2½ hours before game time	Any remaining Numbers distributed, first come first served
1½ hours before game time	Must be present at Gate Ten for priority number to remain valid
