

People in Taiwan Need Help!!

The Disaster : More Than Words can Describe!!

A deadly earthquake struck Taiwan around 1:00 am (Taipei local time) on Tuesday, September 21, 1999. The U.S. Geological Survey reported the quake had a magnitude of 7.6, and more than 5,000 aftershocks afterward. This tragedy has caused tremendous damage to the island. The Interior Ministry of Taiwan said the quake killed at least 2,000 people, and almost 3,000 were believed trapped in the rubble of collapsed buildings. More than 100,000 people are without shelters in the Nantou County and Taichung County alone. People there urgently need help.

Taiwanese Students Association at UCLA will be setting up a booth on Bruin Walk from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM, beginning from September 28, 1999 (Tuesday) to raise funding for this tragic earthquake for Taiwan.
